



Adana With Figures

- 6th Biggest City in terms of population (2,2 Million People)
- Rank 8th biggest city in terms of GDP,
- More than 2 Billion \$ of yearly exports (in 2021),
- Çukurova, center of the agriculture, being among the most fertile plains in the World
- Textile, Food, Chemistry, Plastics, Machinery, Aotumotive and Steel, are among the biggest industries in Adana,
- Adana is a city of festivals, hosting almost 1.000.000 visitors through out the year (Gastronomy, Orange Flower, Koza film festivals etc..)



Turkey – Germany Mutual Partners

- Germany and Turkey are closely linked by the approximately three million people of Turkish descent living in Germany play an important role.
- 80,000 Turkish—German businesses operating in Germany with annual turnover amounts to \$52 billion
- Germany, being the biggest foreign investor in Turkey, There are more than 7400 German or Turkish companies with German equity participation.
- Turkey is an EU candidate country and Germany is Turkey's most important and biggest trading partner in EU.

COVID 19 PANDEMIC

Syrian Refrugees

- Turkey hosts almost 4 Million Syrian Refugees after the crises at Middle East
- Germany is the only EU country that host almost 1 Million refugees,
- Today Adana hosts almost 300.000 STuP's, more than 10% of its total population
- German Government together with EU supported Turkey in the form of humanitarian assistance and to some extend to improve the living conditions of refugees
- In addition to our existing cooperations, a radical and innovative approach is needed to overcome this huge social and economic issue (fostering the demand side rather than the supply side by a waiver for Syrian manufuctured goods)



Global Warming and EU Green Deal Policy,

- Global warming is sure among the main threats for the future of our children
- After the ratification of the Paris Aggreement by Turkish Government, The Green Transformation of Turkish economy in line with EU and German industries is a critical issue for sustainibility of Turkish industries and manufacturing value chains
